

Listening can be a very difficult thing to do. Especially,

when your child needs you to stop and listen to them when you have so many things to do. However, stopping what you are doing and listening to your child makes it more likely that they listen to you, when you want them to.

Just like us, when your child feels listened to, they are more likely to listen.

Talking and listening to your child holds a lot of importance, as it helps your child build a bond with you and develop trust. It improves the bonding in a relationship and builds a child's confidence. You do not have to have the skill to 'listen', but you can always develop the skill to LISTEN.

When you are trying to talk or communicate with your child you should:

- encourage your child to open up with you by talking
- be patient and listen to your child while he puts his feelings and thoughts across
- respond in a sensitive way to everything that he says, good or bad
- focus on body language and actions, so as to understand the nonverbal forms of his communication

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HEAR
